Mystery Bird consists of an illuminated bird cage, a magical sound scape, and projection that will escape, cover the surrounding buildings and thrill an audience of all ages, abilities and accessibility. It fits onto a flatbed truck, runs an 8 minute loop and requires projection surfaces on both sides of the vehicle.

Mystery Bird is a collaboration of five artists: extraordinary paper artist **Helen Musselwhite**, incredible vocal beat-box artist **Jason Singh**, the brilliant projection team **Illuminos**, excellent local designers and fabricators **M3 Industries** and our digital AR expert **Jack Hardiker** who have combined techniques to create this modern-day carnival float - a truly, special unexpected experience.

HIRE FEE

We aim to create **bespoke packages** to fit with your needs. Rate is from £8,500 and includes artwork hire, technician and project management consultation. In addition you will need to supply projectors, generators, PA, travel, accommodation, delivery and collection costs and insurance.

TECHNICAL RIDER

FOOTPRINT:

- Fits onto a flatbed truck 5.79m long and 2m wide
- The birdcage is 3.1m height and 1.75m wide.
- The total height (including van) is 4.1m height.
- If you are presenting a traveling version you will need to hire a flatbed truck and driver.

SITE:

- Mystery Bird travels along the streets but can also be static.
- For the traveling version it needs 4.1m height clearance. 3.5m for the static.
- It can travel slowly over speed bumps and cobbles.
- Projection surfaces are needed both sides.

POWER:

- 3 VOLTstacks (eco generators) are required to run the travelling piece – the hire cost is included in the price. Static presentations could be different.
- You will need to provide 13amp sockets to charge them up overnight/after presentations have finished for the day.
- If doing static version 32 amp is required.

PROJECTION / SOUND:

 You will need to supply the projectors and PA spec supplied and worked out for each location.

INSTALL / DE-RIG:

- 2 days to install with first performance on the evening of second day.
- Large workshop space to install with a minimum ceiling height of 5m and a door way height 4.3m.
- We will provide a projection artist to supervise install and the first performance.
- Technician provided throughout.
- Storage will be required for 5 x flight cases and 1 x pallet.

SECURITY:

- Stewards and Security are required, exact arrangements will depend on presentation format.
- Secure lock up required for the artwork overnight.

TECHNICAL RIDER (CONTINUED)

HOSPITALITY:

- Accommodation & per diems required for all crew for the duration of the event.
- Projection artists require accommodation for install and first night, technician throughout.

TRANSPORTATION:

 Luton or flatbed type vehicle is required – height is required for the birdcage

EQUIPMENT TO TRANSPORT:

- 1x top of bird cage
- 1 x base of bird cage base width 1650mm
- 8 x window frames
- 1 x 18mm, 8x4 Ply Sheet
- 8 x wooden boxes
- 1 x small box of consumables
