HIRE FEE

We aim to create bespoke packages to fit with your needs. The fee is from $\pounds5000$ plus expenses including; technicians, accommodation, travel, freight of artwork and insurance.

TECHNICAL RIDER

FOOTPRINT:

- Youth Culture is 3658mm (12ft) tall in total.
- The sculpture is 3048mm (10ft) tall and sits on a 609mm (2ft) plinth.
- The plinth is approx. 1300mm²
- It weighs approximately 700kg.

SITE:

- As dark area as possible, any overhead street lighting to be switched off
- Space is required for 40ft artic used to install/de-rig.
- 25 to 30 ft clearance for height is required install and de-rig.

POWER REQUIREMENTS:

230v feed via CEE Form 16A input required.

TRANSPORT:

- We are able to provide transport (in the UK) and equipment to hoist the artwork into position.
- Artwork is delivered and collected on an artic, with a lorry mounted crane with a semi-trailer - approx. 40ft long Inc. trailer.

YOU TO PROVIDE:

• 30 x 12.5kg stage weights.

SECURITY:

- 24 hour security required.
- Fencing required if area is not secure when artwork is closed.


INSTALL/DE-RIG:

- Installation and de-rig takes half a day.
- You will be required to provide 1-2 crew members to assist the install and de-rig.
- Parking is required for Artic.

EQUIPMENT TO STORE:

 The case that the sculpture travels in will need to be stored. Length: 4000, Width: 1300, Depth: 1500.




